Ivano-Frankivsk National Technical University of Oil and Gas is the higher educational institution with more than 57 years of history. University is located in western Ukraine, where approximately 8,000 students are studying, 1500+ of which are Master and 150+ are PhD students. There are 700+ members of academic staff including 90 professors.



The structure of the university consists of 7 educational and scientific institutes:

Petroleum Engineering;

Mechanical Engineering;

Tourism and Geosciences;

Economics and Management;

Architecture, Construction and Power Engineering;

Information Technologies;

Humanities and Public Administration.

Innovation infrastructure of the university includes 29 R&D laboratories, Institute of Oil and Gas Power Engineering and Ecology, Technology transfer office, Exhibition Center, Technical committee for Standardization UA/TC146 (member of ISO/TC67, EASC/ITC523, CEN/TC12), Research and Education Centre "Energy-efficient technologies for oil and gas drilling, production and transition", Research Centre "Shale gas", Drilling Personnel Training Centre (accredited by IWCF), Oil and Gas Technological Park LLC, Center of Innovation Development, 3 joint research centers with Institutes of National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine and a number of research groups.



Educational activities are focused at hands-on skills and raising the employability of graduates at national and foreign oil and gas companies. Research fields vary from prospection,

drilling, production and transportation of oil and gas, servicing, instrumentations to sector economics, energy-efficiency, sustainable development and technological safety and security.

International contacts cover Europe, Asia and North America. International student-level contacts and cooperation is performed by local committee SPE (university charter recognized the best in 2014 by Society of Petroleum Engineers).



The educational and scientific activities of the university correspond to international standards and are certified to meet the requirements of State Standard of Ukraine ISO 9001:2009 "Quality Management System. Requirements".

Collaboration with foreign scientific and educational institutions includes: participation in international projects, participation in international conferences and exhibitions, support of students mobility to gain higher education in accordance with the Bologna Declaration, training of students and professor staff. The University participates in international programs funded by the European Union. At the moment, IFNTUOG is a member of the European University Association.

IFNTUOG has signed agreements on scientific and educational cooperation with 30 universities from all over the world including 18 European universities.

IFNTUOG successfully cooperates in educational sphere on double degree diplomas with AGH University of Science and Technology (Krakow, Poland), Uniwersytet Pomorski w Słupsku (Słupsk, Poland) and London South Bank University (London, UK). About 100 graduates of IFNTUOG receive both Ukrainian and European diplomas every year.

The University constantly maintains close interaction with specialized enterprises and organizations, which is confirmed by cooperation agreements, agreements for the performance of scientific research, experimental design works.

At the present day, university reported on completion of more than 500 research works in last 5 years in the field of sustainable development of energy industry (oil and gas, nuclear and renewables) funded by Ukrainian government and public/private companies along with project funded by EU, US and other parties.

The purpose of the university is to facilitate participation of Ukrainian organizations, universities and research institutes, industry, small and medium enterprises in research programs of the European Union and becoming a part of the European scientific community.
